Grade 6: Book News – students presented book reviews and shared their reflections.


Grade 7: Character Analysis – learners explored personalities from their favourite stories with creativity and insight.





## ROBOTICS

*"Cleanliness is the first step to good health!"*









# LEARNING BY DOING


